



## **Course Overview**

Increased specialization and rapid advances in hospital medicine have made it difficult for clinicians who provide inpatient care to stay updated on new procedures, treatments and medication protocols. "Hospital Medicine Update: A Full System Review" will provide updates on the latest evidence-based guidelines and best strategies for diagnosing and treating conditions such as heart failure, chronic obstructive pulmonary disease, endocarditis, neurologic diseases, the use of medical marijuana, advocacy in hospital medicine and much more.
